C.C.C. 3.20.010 Purpose. The Board of Clallam County Commissioners finds and declares that RCW 38.52.070(1) provides that "each local organization for emergency services shall have a director, who shall be appointed by the executive head of the political subdivision . . . " and that the position of Sheriff is compatible with that of Director of Emergency Services.

- C.C.C. 3.20.020 Sheriff as Director of Emergency Services. In accord with RCW 38.52.070(1) the Clallam County Sheriff shall serve as Director of Clallam County Emergency Services and in said capacity, shall have those powers, duties and functions as determined by Chapter 38.52 RCW.
- C.C.C. 3.20.030 Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this chapter is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this chapter; it being herein expressly declared that this chapter and each section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause and phrase thereof would have been adopted irrespective of the fact that any one or more other section, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

C.C.C. 3.20.040 Effective Date. The effective date of this chapter shall be January 1, 1980.
