BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CLALLAM COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS:

Section 1. Delete C.C.C. 23.04.010 General Regulation:

~~((All-vehicles-must-stay-in-the-designated-parking-area  
for-overnight-camping.--Camping-will-be-allowed-only-in-numbered  
campsites.--Only-one-vehicle-per-site-will-be-allowed,-unless  
otherwise-designated.))~~

Section 2. Add a new Section C.C.C. 23.04.010 Purpose:

The fee schedules in this chapter are hereby adopted for  
services provided by the Clallam County Park Department.

Section 3. Add a new Section C.C.C. 23.04.020 Definitions:

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall,  
unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, have the meanings  
as follows:

(1) "County residents". Those persons who possess one of the  
following:

- (a) license plate beginning with ~~WA~~ or "PU",
- (b) a driver's license with a Clallam County address, or
- (c) a voter's registration card showing a Clallam County  
precinct.

*the RMC "CL", "CA", "CN", a Clallam County  
precinct.*

(2) "Senior Citizen". A person sixty-two years old or older.

(3) "Non-profit Organization". A group of people under the age  
of eighteen, functioning as a group under non-profit restrictions.

(4) "Group Camping". Individuals traveling as a group who wish  
to camp in designated group camping areas.

(5) "County Groups". Those groups having a Clallam County address.

Section 4. Amend Section C.C.C. 23.04.030 Fees: Overnight Camping  
to read as follows:

Section 5. C.C.C. 23.04.040 Fees: Dump Station. There shall be no charge for use of the dump stations by county residents or by paying campers. Out-of-county residents shall be assessed Two Dollars (\$2.00) for use of the dump stations, each use.

Section 6. Amend Section C.C.C. 23.04.050 Fees: Picnicking to read as follows:

Section 7. Amend Section C.C.C. 23.04.060 Effective Date to read as follows: This chapter shall become effective ~~(ten-(10)-days-after-adoption)~~ January 1, 1980.
