ORDINANCE NO. 137, 1981.

An ordinance amending C.C.C. 1.01 providing for codification of ordinances not heretofore codified.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

CHAPTER 1.01
CODIFICATION

Section 1. Amend C.C.C. 1.01.010, Codification, to read as follows:

There is hereby established the Clallam County Code, which will be a codification of all of the ordinances of permanent and general effect of Clallam County, Washington. Upon adoption of an ordinance as a portion of the code, in accordance with the procedures of this chapter, the codified ordinance shall be the official form of ordinances of Clallam County ~~((--))~~; provided, that codification, pursuant to C.C.C. 1.01.100, of any existing ordinances of Clallam County, Washington, not heretofore codified shall not act as repealer of said ordinances. Said existing ordinances, as they appeared prior to codification, shall remain the official form of such ordinances, until repealed or amended.

Section 2. Amend C.C.C. 1.01.100, prior ordinances, subsection (1), to read as follows:

(1) Ordinances adopted prior to the date of this ordinance, except those ordinances which state they are adopted as a chapter of this code, shall be codified in accordance with the procedures of this section. ~~((and Section 110-(C.C.C.-1.01.100-110)-))~~

Section 3. Delete the following subsections of C.C.C. 1.01.100:


~~((2)-The ordinances shall first be edited to the extent necessary to modernize and clarify the language of the ordinance.--The Board may make such changes as it deems necessary in the substance of the ordinance.--The ordinance shall then be prepared in accordance with the form set forth in C.C.C. 1.01.040-.060 above.))~~


~~((3)--Subsequent to the preparation of the ordinance in the form required by this chapter, pursuant of subsection two (2) of this section, the commissioners may proceed to adopt the revised form of the prior ordinance.--Adoption of the material in the revised form~~

~~shall constitute repeal of the prior ordinance. In adopting an ordinance, the commissioners shall follow all procedures required by the Clallam County Home Rule Charter, and state law, and shall enumerate these prior ordinances repealed.)~~

Section 4. Amend C.C.C. 1.01.100, by adding the following new subsection (2):

Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, all existing ordinances of Clallam County, Washington, not heretofore codified, shall be placed in code form, as set forth in C.C.C. 1.01.040-.050, by the Prosecuting Attorney. No substantive changes shall be made to such ordinances. Codification of such ordinances shall not act as a repealer, and such ordinances shall remain binding and effective in their present form, until repealed or amended.

Section 5. Amend C.C.C. 1.01.110, prior ordinances - not yet codified, as follows:

Those ordinances of Clallam County existing and effective at the time of adoption of this ordinance shall remain effective and binding until such time as they are ~~((adopted by ordinance of the Board as a part of this code.))~~ repealed or amended.
