ORDINANCE NO. 170, 1982

An Ordinance amending C.C.C. 23.02<sup>13</sup> to prohibit overnight camping in the specified county parks and defining park hours.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

SECTION 1

Add Subsection 8 to C.C.C. 23.03.040 CAMPING:

C.C.C. 23.03.040 CAMPING:

- 8. Overnight camping is hereby prohibited at the following Clallam County Parks: Marlyn Nelson Park at Port Williams, Freshwater Bay County Park, Lake Aldwell County Park, Lake Pleasant County Park, Leyendecker County Park and Clallam Bay Community Beach. Overnight camping is hereby prohibited at Pillar Point County Park except (1) during the posted season when the county employed ranger is on duty to register campers and maintain the campground, and (2) during the off-season after obtaining an Off-Season Special Use Permit and following the rules and regulations pertaining to this permit. (Sold for an annual fee of \$10.00 to county residents only).

SECTION 2

Add Subsection 3 as follows to Section C.C.C. 23.03.050 CLOSURES:

C.C.C. 23.03.050 CLOSURES:

- 3. Park hours for open public use are established as follows:

- a. The following parks will be closed one hour after sunset until one hour before sunrise:

Marlyn Nelson Park at Port Williams, Freshwater Bay Park, Lake Aldwell Park, Lake Pleasant Community Beach, Leyendecker County Park, and Clallam Bay Community Beach.

- 11. Use of or being at these areas during closed hours is hereby prohibited.

- b. Public use of Salt Creek Recreation Area and Dungeness Recreation Area unless registered to camp shall be the below listed hours:

<u>November, December, January, February</u>	<u>7 A.M. - 5 P.M.</u>
<u>March</u>	<u>7 A.M. - 6 P.M.</u>
<u>April</u>	<u>7 A.M. - 8 P.M.</u>
<u>May</u>	<u>6 A.M. - 9 P.M.</u>
<u>June, July, August</u>	<u>6 A.M. - 10 P.M.</u>
<u>September</u>	<u>6 A.M. - 9 P.M.</u>
<u>October</u>	<u>7 A.M. - 6 P.M.</u>

Use of or being at these areas outside these designated times is hereby prohibited.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect ten days after adoption.

## COOPERATIVE USE AGREEMENT

1. All rules and regulations established and ordained by the Clallam County Park Board and Board of Commissioners shall apply to Special Off-Season Permit users.
2. Fires are prohibited during the off season!
3. Camping is allowed only on the parking lot levels during the off-season and prohibited in the designated campground area that is closed off.
4. No one shall dump sewage of any kind at the site. (There are two vault toilets available for use. The restroom will be closed and no water will be available for off-season use.)
5. Campers are responsible for their own safety, sanitation, and security. The Clallam County Park Department does not provide regular supervision of this site during the off-season.
6. Camping is limited to six (6) consecutive days. After the sixth day the camping vehicle must be removed for at least 48 hours.
7. Campers must call in a reservation for use prior to the dates they wish to camp. (Camper must phone 452-7831, ext. 291, Clallam County Park office, and give the office the following information: Permit No. and dates of intended use). Any campers not calling in a registration of dates will be asked to leave the park until they have done so. Repeated abuse will result in revokation of the permit.
8. Failure to comply with any rules or regulations hereby printed or referred to will result in immediate revokation of this permit without refund.

"Please help us keep this park open. Pick up your litter, follow good camping practices, and notify the Park office of any misuse or problems you see while camping at Pillar Point." Thank you.
