

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 20 1966

This is an amendment to Ordinance No. 20 1966 of the Clallam County Commissioners regulating the use of certain types of firearms in designated areas of Clallam County, Washington, and adding a portion of land thereto.

WHEREAS, the use of firearms has been increasing in the more populated areas in Clallam County and is now becoming a menace to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Clallam County; and

WHEREAS, the use of all types of firearms in these areas should be regulated for the health, safety and welfare of all of the citizens of Clallam County using and living in the areas designated hereinafter, or residing in the areas near thereto; and

WHEREAS, the uncontrolled use of firearms in the areas designated hereinafter is dangerous to all citizens of Clallam County and should be regulated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF the County of Clallam as follows:

Section 1: This is an amendment to Ordinance No. 20 1966 and adding on an additional piece of property to be regulated by Ordinance No. 20.

Section 2: That no hunting or shooting with rifles or pistols of any type shall be allowed on the following described property:

Beginning at a point Three Hundred (300) feet more or less North of the center of Section 33, Township 31 North, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian; thence South through the center of Section 33 Six Hundred (600) feet more or less to the top of the bluff; thence in a Northeasterly direction along the top of the bluff to One-Sixteenth corner Thirteen Hundred Thirty (1330) feet North of the quarter corner between Sections

33 and 34, Township 31 North, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian; thence East Six Hundred Sixty (660) feet more or less; thence North Fifteen Hundred (1500) feet more or less to the South end of Elwha Dike; thence North along the East edge of the Dike; thence North along the West bank of river to the Stratis of Juan de Fuca.

Section 3: Provided however, that the use of shotguns is permitted in this area with either shot or ball.

Section 4: It is further provided that target shooting of rifles and pistols with backstops sufficient to insure the safety of all the citizens of Clallam County is permitted.

Section 5: Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed Guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject upon conviction to a fine of not more than TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days in the Clallam County Jail for each violation.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passing and after proper notice given as required by law.

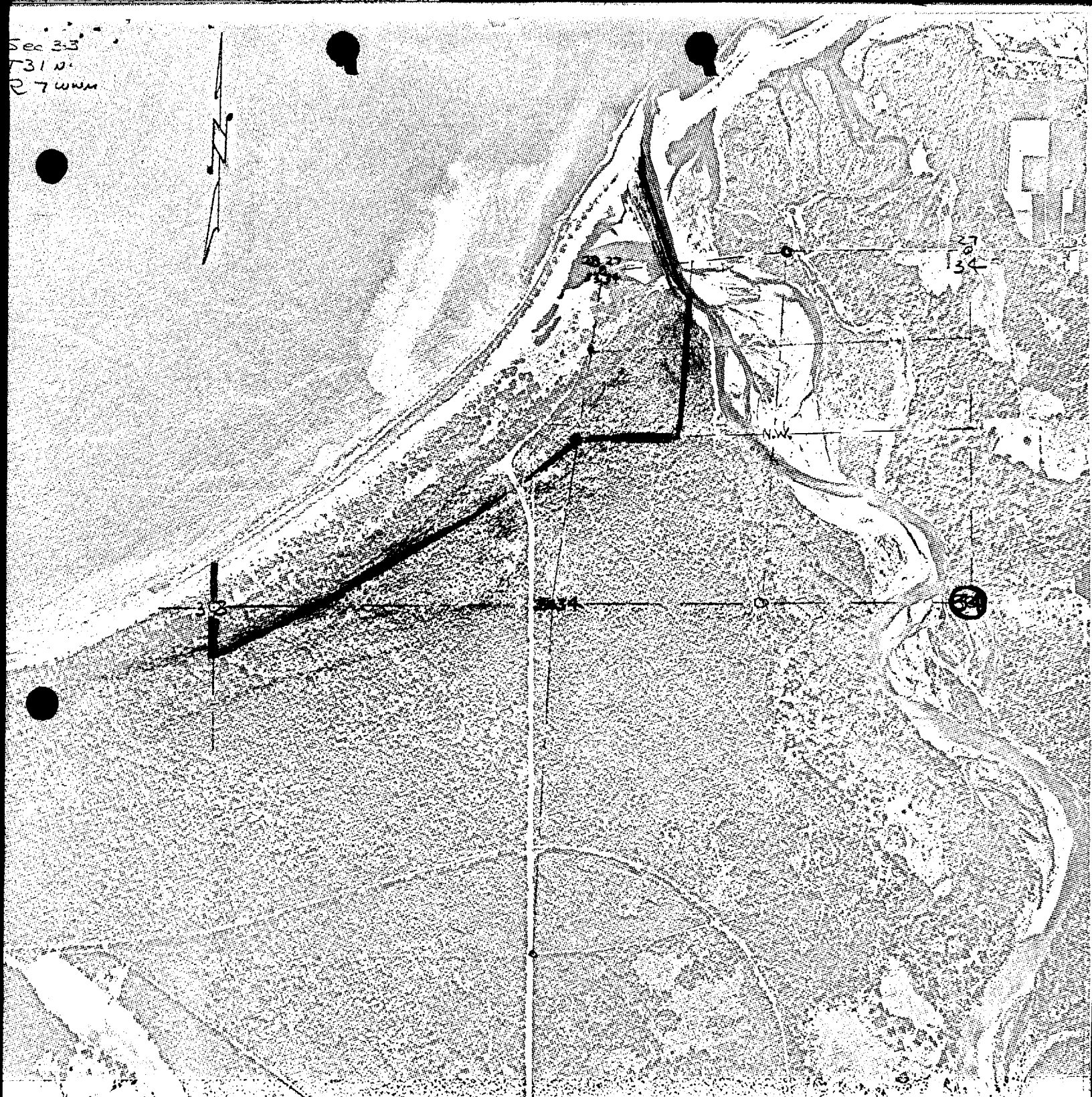

An ordinance regulating the use of certain types of firearms in designated areas of Clallam County, Washington.

WHEREAS, the use of firearms has been increasing in the more populated areas in Clallam County and is now becoming a menace to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Clallam County; and

WHEREAS, the use of all types of firearms in these areas should be regulated for the health, safety and welfare of all of the citizens of Clallam County using and living in the areas designated hereinafter, or residing in the areas near thereto; and

WHEREAS, the uncontrolled use of firearms in the areas designated hereinafter is dangerous to all citizens of Clallam County and should be regulated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF the County of Clallam as follows:

Section 1. That no hunting or shooting with rifles or pistols of any types shall be allowed on the following described property:

Section 15, the East three-quarters of Section 16 and the North half of Section 21 and 22, all in Township 30 North, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Clallam County, Washington.

Section 2. Provided however, that the use of shotguns is permitted in this area with either shot or ball.

Section 3. It is further provided that target shooting of rifles and pistols with backstops sufficient to insure the safety of all the citizens of Clallam County is permitted.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed Guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject upon conviction to a fine of not more than TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days in the Clallam County Jail for each violation.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passing and after proper notice given as required by law.
