

ORDINANCE NO. 23 1967

Repealed by Ordinance No. 40, 1981

An ordinance regulating the use of firearms in designated areas of Clallam County, Washington.

WHEREAS, the use of firearms has been increasing in the more populated areas in Clallam County and is now becoming a menace to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Clallam County; and

WHEREAS, the use of all types of firearms in these areas should be regulated for the health, safety and welfare of all of the citizens of Clallam County using and living in the areas designated hereinafter, or residing in the areas near thereto; and

WHEREAS, the uncontrolled use of firearms in the areas designated hereinafter is dangerous to all citizens of Clallam County and should be regulated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF The County of Clallam as follows:

Section 1. That no hunting or shooting with rifles or pistols of any type shall be allowed on the following described property:

~~Section 29, South of Highway #101, and all of Section 32, Township 30 North, Range 7 W.W.M.~~

That designated area consists of all of Sections 5 and 8, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, W.M. bounded by the Milwaukee Railroad on the West, South and East to a point 173 feet West of the center of Section 8; thence Easterly along center line of the Section 600 feet more or less to the Cedar Park Drive; thence Southeasterly 1000 feet more or less; thence Northerly along said road to the North line of Section 8; thence West on said Section line 500 feet; thence North to the Strait of Juan de Fuca.

Section 2. Provided however, that the use of shotguns is permitted in this area with either shot or ball.


Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed Guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject upon conviction to a fine


of not more than TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days in the Clallam County Jail for each violation.


Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passing and after proper notice given as required by law.




