NOTICE OF TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING A PROPOSED ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clallam County has been informed that the inhalation of sundry chemical substances and/or compunds has been a serious social problem, and efforts consequently should be made in an attempt to eradicate such evils, therefore, said Board in regular session assembled has considered a proposed ordinance in words and figures following, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 29, 1969

AN ORDINANCE of Clallam County, State of Washington, relating to solvent inhalation; declaring the violation thereof to be a misdemeanor and providing penalties.

The Board of County Commissioners for Clallam County, State of Washington, do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to smell or inhale, for the purpose of becoming intoxicated, inebriated, excited, or stupefied, the fumes from any glue, cement, or any other adhesive containing one or more of the following chemical compounds: acetone, acetate benzine, butyl alcohol, ethyl alcohol, anthylene, dicloride, isopropyl alcohol, methyl ethyl ketone, pentacholorophanol, petroleum ether or toluene.

Section 2. That any probative evidence relevant, competent and material offered at a trial for the violation of this ordiance shall be deemed and considered prima facie of intent upon the part of the accused to induce intoxication, inebriation, excitement or stupefaction,

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that this ordinance shall never be construed as prohibitive of the inhalation of any anesthetic for medical or dental purposes.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by
