BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

Add new sections C.C.C. 15.24.030 and 15.24.040: All new material shall be underlined.

chapter M C.C.C. 15.24.030. Possession of Liquor.

(1) For purposes of this section only, in addition to its ordinary and customary usage, "possession of liquor" includes the presence of alcohol in a person's bloodstream.

- (2) For purposes of this section only, "consume" not only includes the putting of liquor to any use, whether by drinking or otherwise, but also includes the process of assimilating alcohol into the bloodstream.
- C.C.C. 15.24.040. Minor in Public Place After Having Consumed Liquor. It is unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to be or remain in any public place after having consumed liquor while another can detect, sense or observe symptoms indicating that the person presently has alcohol in his bloodstream or is in the process of assimilating alcohol into his bloodstream.
