ORDINANCE # 359, 1989

An ordinance amending Clallam County Code Chapter 3.30:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

Section 1. Amend C.C.C. 3.30.035 Fee Waiver. The application fee for a rezone and comprehensive plan amendment and associated environmental evaluation specified in C.C.C. 3.30.020 may be waived by the Clallam County Board of Commissioners only for minor zoning boundary adjustments ((rezones)) involving parcels intersected by a zone boundary common to a residential and forestry zone, as specified in C.C.C. 33 and C.C.C. 27.01. This fee waiver shall not apply to parcels where the zoning boundary was placed on a natural or man-made boundary, such as a road, street, stream, river, ravine, hilltop or any other natural or man-made feature which make logical zoning boundaries. If granted, such waiver shall not prejudice the Board's subsequent action on the application which was a subject of the waiver. Applicants are responsible to initiate the waiver request. The Board shall act on all such requests at a public meeting. All such waiver requests shall be acted on by the Board prior to initiation of the rezone application.

Section 2. The Board has determined that this amendment is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective ten days after adoption.
