C.C.C. 23.04.010. Purpose. The fee schedules in this chapter are hereby adopted for services provided by the Clallam County Parks Department.

Amend Section C.C. 23.04.020. Definitions. As used in this chapter, the following terms shall, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, have the meanings as follows:

- 1. "County Residents": those persons who possess one of the following:
 - a. A driver's license with a Clallam County address; or
 - b. A voter's registration card showing a Clallam County precinct.
- 2. "Senior Citizen": a person sixty-two years old or older.
- 3. "Non-profit Organization": a group of people under the age of eighteen, functioning as a group under non-profit restrictions.
- 4. "Group Camping": individuals traveling as a group who wish to camp in designated group camping areas.
 - 5. "County Groups": those groups having a Clallam County address.

Amend Section C.C.C. 23.04.030. Fees: Overnight Camping.

Off season camping permit for Pillar Point shall be ((\$10.00)) \$12.00 per year. This permit does not include use during the posted camping season. During the posted season or when a ranger is on site to collect fees, campers must pay daily camp fee shown above. Campground area is closed in off season; camping is allowed with permit on lower parking lot only.

((2))(3) A second vehicle fee of \$3.00 shall be charged when adequate site space is available, and the Park Manager allows a second vehicle to be parked in a campsite overnight. Vehicle shall be registered on self-registration envelope and fee paid.

((3))(4) Camp David Jr.

Fees for Camp David ((Junior)) Jr. shall be based on facilities used with minimum charges based on rated capacities.

a. Charges for overnight use by large groups (21-100 campers) shall include use of main kitchen, dining hall and lodge and shall be as follows, provided that additional \$1.00 per cabin per day shall be charged during winter (Oct. 1 - April 30):

Firewood Fee will be ((\$5.00))\$10.00 per day for each use of Log Cabin fires, Lodge fires, and outdoor fires unless users bring and burn their own wood.

C.C.C. 23.03.040. Fees: Dump Station. There shall be no charge for use of the dump stations by county residents or by paying campers. Out-of-county residents shall be assessed two dollars (\$2.00) for use of the dump stations for each use.
