

An Ordinance classifying county roads and requiring compensation to the county from persons benefiting from vacations of such roads.

WHEREAS, RCW 36.87.100, .110, and .120 provides that county commissioners may, by ordinance classify county roads on the basis of the county's interest in such roads and on the basis of other factors, and;

WHEREAS, the above-referred to statutes provide that the county may required compensation from persons benefiting from the vacation of county roads, now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Clallam County that the Engineer and Road Department are hereby directed to classify all county roads for which public expenditures were made in the acquisition, improvement or maintenance of the same, according to the type and amount of expenditures made and the nature of the county's property interest in the road, and they are further directed to separately classify county roads for which public expenditures have not been made in the acquisition, improvement or maintenance of the same, according to the nature of the county's property interest in the road.

It is FURTHER HEREBY ORDAINED that there shall be required, prior to the vacation of any county road, compensation for said road in an amount equal to the appraised value of the vacated road as of the effective date of the vacation. Costs of county appraisals of roads pursuant to this ordinance shall be deemed expenses incurred in vacation proceedings, and shall be paid in the manner provided by RCW 36.87.070 as adopted and as thereafter amended.
