

ORDINANCE NO. 554, 1994

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 9.08 OF THE CLALLAM COUNTY CODE (C.C.C.), WHICH CHAPTER ESTABLISHES THE PROCEDURES FOR CHANGING THE NAMES OF COUNTY ROADS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

Amend Chapter 9.08 of the Clallam County Code (C.C.C.) to read as follows: "All new material shall be underlined, material deleted shall be placed within double parentheses and scored through."

C.C.C. 9.08.010. Purpose. The County has developed and adopted comprehensive and uniform road naming and addressing systems as components of the 911 emergency response system. These systems have eliminated previous local area road name duplications and eliminated future county wide road name duplications. In order to preserve the integrity of addressing system, it is in the best interests of the County that county road names and private road names will not be changed. ((No written policy governing the changing of names of county roads now exists, and said lack of policy has caused confusion and disagreement between land owners residing on said roads. A policy

is needed to establish procedures, including notification of residents on roads of proposed change, and to establish costs thereof consisting of postings of notifications, advertising, mailing of notices, re-signing and any other related costs.))

~~((C.C.C. 9.08.020. Petition Required. A petition furnished by the Department of Public Works must be completed by the requesters of county road name changes showing the following:))~~

~~((A. Name of existing road))~~

~~((B. Proposed road name))~~

~~((C. Reason for name change))~~

~~((D. Signatures of a majority of abutting landowners.))~~

~~((E. Neatly drawn map of the road with ownerships drawn on an 8 1/2" X 14" or larger paper-))~~

~~((F. Names and mailing addresses of all residents and/or landowners on the road))~~

~~((C.C.C. 9.08.030. Fee. Petitions shall be accompanied by the sum of two hundred, fifty dollars (\$250.00) to be paid to the Department of Public Works as compensation of expenses incurred in the advertising, posting of Notice of Hearing, re-signing, and any other related costs, provided that the fee shall be returned for any proposal rejected by the director of public works pursuant to C.C.C. 9.08.050.))~~

~~((C.C.C. 9.08.040. County Proposals. Proposals for road name changes initiated by the County shall not require a petition or fee but shall otherwise comply with this Chapter.))~~

~~((C.C.C. 9.08.050. Conflicting Road Names. No proposal will be processed for a road name change which in the opinion of the Director of Public Works would result in a name similar to any known public or private road or street.))~~

~~((C.C.C. 9.08.060. Publication and Notification. All proposals for road name changes shall be published in the county official newspaper ten (10) days preceding the date of hearing which shall be at a regular meeting of the Board of Clallam County Commissioners. Copies of the hearing will be posted on said road for the same period of time running concurrently, at each end of said road, and at other locations along said road as may be deemed appropriate. Notification of the proposed change and hearing date shall be mailed to each property owner on said road.))~~

~~((C.C.C. 9.08.070. Notification of Name Change. In the event that the Board determines that the road name shall be changed, the Department of Public Works shall notify all applicable public agencies and the abutting landowners as shown on the original petition.))~~

~~((C.C.C. 9.08.080. Severability. If any portion of this ordinance or any application thereof is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion thereof or any application thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance or its applicability to other persons or circumstances.))~~

C.C.C. 9.08.((090))020. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after this adoption.
