

ORDINANCE NO. 569, 1995

An Ordinance providing for the marking of county-owned passenger motor vehicles in the lower left hand corner of the rear window.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

C.C.C. Chapter 11.13A

Marking of County Owned Passenger Motor Vehicles

Sections:

- 11.13.020 Alternative Vehicle Marking Authorized

C.C.C. 3.31.010 Purpose. R.C.W. 46.08.065 provides for the conspicuous marking of publicly owned vehicles used on public highways with insignia on right and left sides of the vehicles. An exception may be granted by the governing body to allow for marking plainly and conspicuously in the lower left-hand corner of the rear window with the name of the agency, the county insignia and the words "Clallam County - for official use only). This type of marking is desired for some of the Clallam County fleet.

C.C.C. 11.13.020 Alternative Vehicle Marking Authorized. All county-owned public vehicles operated on public highways shall be marked in accordance with all provisions, alternatively, of RCW 46.08.065 as now or hereafter amended.

C.C.C. 11.13.030 Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from adoption of this ordinance.
