ORDINANCE NO. 612, 1997

An ordinance extending the Clallam County Interim Critical Areas Ordinance, Chapter 27.12, Clallam County Code. (Ordinance 471, 1992, Ordinance 493, 1992, Ordinance 533, 1993, and Ordinance 609, 1997)

- Section 1 This ordinance extends the Clallam County Interim Critical Areas Ordinance, adopted under Ordinance 471, 1992, amended under Ordinance 493, 1992 and Ordinance 533, 1993, and extended sixty (60) days under Ordinance 609, 1997, ninety (90) days.
- Section 2 This ordinance is adopted under the authority of Section 3.10 of the Clallam County Charter.
- Section 3 This ordinance shall cease to be effective on July 24, 1997. The Board of Clallam County Commissioners may terminate this ordinance upon adoption of critical area protection rules consistent with the Clallam County Comprehensive Plan, Title 31, Clallam County Code, that become effective prior to the expiration date of this ordinance.
- Section 4 This ordinance shall come into full force and effect the date Ordinance 609, 1997, ceases to be effective, but not sooner than ten (10) days after adoption by the Board of Clallam County Commissioners.
