An ordinance establishing the value of a day of incarceration where a criminal defendant is incarcerated for failure to pay court-ordered fines and costs

Chapter 15.31

REDUCTION OF COURT-ORDERED FINES AND COSTS

Sections:

- 15.31.010 Reduction for Labor Performed
15.31.020 Reduction Where No Labor Performed

C.C.C. 15.31.010. Reduction for Labor Performed. Any person ordered into the custody of the Clallam County Corrections Facility until the fines and costs adjudged against him or her have been paid, shall have the total amount of the fines and costs reduced by eight (8) times the hourly minimum wage, as established by the State of Washington, for each day, or part thereof, of incarceration that the person performs labor as provided in RCW 10.82.040, as now or hereafter amended.

C.C.C. 15.31.020. Reduction Where No Labor Performed. Any person ordered into the custody of the Clallam County Corrections Facility until the fines and costs adjudged against him or her have been paid shall have the total amount of the fines and costs reduced by 50 percent (50%) of the amount established in Section 1 of this Ordinance for every day, or part thereof, of incarceration that the person serves without performing labor while confined as provided in RCW 10.82.040, as now or hereafter amended.
