

Ordinance No. 716, 2001

An ordinance repealing and replacing Chapter 23.04 of the Clallam County Code, "Fee Schedules" relating to fees for use of County Parks facilities.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

C.C.C. 23.04.010. Purpose. The fee schedules in this chapter are hereby adopted for services provided by the Clallam County Parks Department.

C.C.C. 23.04.020. Definitions. As used in this chapter, the following terms shall, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, have the meanings as follows:

- (1) "County residents" means those persons who possess one of the following:
 - (a) A driver's license with a Clallam County address; or
 - (b) A voter's registration card showing a Clallam County precinct.
- (2) "Nonprofit youth organization" means a group of people under the age of eighteen (18), functioning as a group under nonprofit restrictions.
- (3) "Group camping" means individuals traveling as a group who wish to camp in designated group camping areas.
- (4) "County groups" means those groups having a Clallam County address, with 75 percent of the group being Clallam County residents.

C.C.C. 23.04.030. Fees – Overnight Camping.

(1)	Dungeness and Salt Creek	\$10.00/campsite	\$12.00/campsite	\$1.50/person

(2) Off-season camp permits for Pillar Point shall be \$40.00 per season. The season shall be from September 20th through April 30th only. Camping will be permitted on the lower parking lot only and users must comply with park rules and regulations issued by the Department.

(3) A second vehicle fee of \$3.00 shall be charged when adequate site space is available and the Park Manager allows a second vehicle to be parked in a campsite overnight. The vehicle shall be registered on self-registration envelope and fee paid.

(4) Camp David Jr. fees shall be based on facilities used with minimum charges based on rated capacities.

(a) Charges for overnight use by large groups (32 to 100 campers) shall include use of the main kitchen, dining hall and lodge and shall be as follows, provided that an additional \$2.00 per cabin per day shall be charged during winter (October 1st through April 30th), and the three cabins shall not include the beach cabin:

Cots for additional capacity (each)	\$2.00/day	\$3.00/day	\$4.00/day

(b) Charges for overnight use by small groups and families (1 to 31 campers) shall be as follows, provided that an additional \$2.00 per cabin per day shall be charged during winter (October 1st through April 30th):

Staff Duplex #11 (per side)	\$15.00/day	\$20.00/day
Beach Cabin #13 (Mon-Thu)	\$35.00/day	\$55.00/day

Staff Cabin B (when available)	\$30.00/day	\$35.00/day

(c) Charges for day use of lodge shall be as follows:

1-50	No	\$50.00/day	\$80.00/day
1-50	Yes	\$75.00/day	\$125.00/day
51-125	No	\$75.00/day	\$125.00/day

(d) One policy manual per organization will be provided at no charge; additional copies are available for \$1.00 each.

(e) Firewood fee will be \$10.00 per day for each use of log cabin fires, lodge fires, and outdoor fires unless users bring and burn their own wood.

23.04.040. Fees – Dump Station. There shall be no charge for use of the dump stations by registered campers. Drop-in use of dump station shall be \$3.00 per use for County residents and \$5.00 per use for non-County residents.

23.04.050. Fees – Firewood and Showers. There shall be fees for firewood and showers as set by the Parks Department, and may be changed by the Director as needed.

23.04.060. Fees – Special Occasion Permits or Uses. Fees for special occasion uses shall be set on a case by case basis by the Director for uses which fall outside the general fees and charges of this Ordinance or are not specifically covered under this or other Ordinances. Fees shall be based on the additional costs placed on the Department to accommodate the use, including, but not limited to, staff time including benefits, equipment time, supply costs, utilities, and/or fair market rent.

23.04.070. Fees – Dungeness Group Area Fees. Group must consist of at least fifteen but not more than fifty people. Above this limit, group must apply for Special Occasion Permit.

Non-profit Youth Organization:

Non-refundable reservation fee paid in advance	\$22.50/night
Plus per person fee for over 15 people charged upon arrival	\$1.50/night

Other Groups:

Non-refundable reservation fee paid in advance	\$30.00/night
Plus per person fee charged upon arrival	\$1.50/night

23.04.080. Violation, Penalties.

(1) Any person who fails to pay the proper fees provided for in this chapter shall be deemed guilty of an infraction and shall be fined \$100 for each violation.


(2) Any person who violates the provisions of this chapter or the rules and regulations promulgated by Clallam County shall be removed from park land.

23.04.090. Repealer. Ordinance No. 97, 1978, and subsequent amending ordinances 113, 153, 158, 178, 219, 252, 281, 298, 336, 412, 440, and 536 shall hereby be repealed and replaced with this ordinance. Prosecution for any violation of the former ordinances occurring prior to the effective date of this chapter provision shall not be affected or abated.

23.04.100. Effective Date. This chapter shall become effective ten days after adoption. It shall not apply to those groups or users that have already registered for use of Camp David Jr., but shall apply to all subsequent uses.
